

István P. Székely is a Co-Editor-in-Chief of Acta Oeconomica and an Honorary Professor of Corvinus University of Budapest. He is an economist by training with a PhD from the University of Cambridge. Before returning to academia, he had a distinguished international policymaking career. He was a general manager at the National Bank of Hungary, a mission chief at the IMF, and a country director in the Directorate-General for Economic and Financial Affairs of the European Commission.
